MOTION TO EXTEND TIME FOR TRANSMITTING RECORD

Petitioner shows to the court as follows:

1. Notice of appeal to the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit was filed herein by petitioner on the 28th day of March, 1975.
2. On April 8, 1975, petitioner ordered from Mrs. Brenda Fellicciotti, reporter at the evidentiary hearing in this case, a transcript of the proceedings which he deemed necessary for inclusion in the record.
