As can be noted on the first page of the Laboratory worksheet. lead smears from the curbstone were examined spectrographically. In a Memorandum of Points and Authorities filed in U. S. District Court for the District of Columbia, Weisberg has asked for 'this spectrographic testing." An exhaustive search of pertinent files. and storage locations has not turned up the spectrographic plates nor the notes made therefrom. Therefore, by affadavit, Kilty can say that the FBI Laboratory has turned over to Weisberg all the material it has concerning the spectrographic lead smears from the curbstone. block disque it symbols and relative Concert to the s.
