The Select Committee requests access to the following materials on or before Tuesday, November 11, 1975:

1. All materials pertaining to Lee Harvey Oswald that were in the files of any FBI field office at any time on or before November 22, 1963.
2. All materials pertaining to the transmittal to FBI headquarters and/or the Warren Commission of any of the materials produced in response to item 1 above.
3. All materials received from any third person or other Federal agency pertaining to Lee Harvey Oswald dated and/or prepared on or prior to November 22, 1963, but received at either FBI headquarters or at an FBI field office subsequent to November 22, 1963.
4. All materials--including photographs--pertaining to a November 23, 1963 examination of the Presidential limosine SS-100-X conducted in the White House garage by FBI representatives Bartlett, Killian, Cunningham, Frazier and Thomas.
5. All materials pertaining to the FBI's internal inquiries into what Deputy Associate Director James B. Adams referred to in his October 21, 1975 testimony before the

Subcommittee on Civil and Constitutional Rights of  
the House Committee on the Judiciary as the "much-  
publicized report concerning an alleged teletype mes-  
sage from FBI headquarters that was allegedly re-

1963...and purportedly warned that a militant revo-  
lutionary group might attempt to assassinate Presi-  
dent Kennedy during his November 22nd visit in Dallas."
