New Test Said to Ald Police N 3 Trapping Gun Suspects

In Trapping Gun Suspects WASHINGTON, Aug. 18 (UPI)—A new test has been developed that would make it easier for police to prove that a suspect had fired a gun and possibly to determine the brand of ammunition used from traces of metal on the suspect's hands, the Aerospace Corporation said Wednesday. Peter F. Jones, an Aerospace scientist at El Segundo, Calif., who directed the Government-financed research, said the Jest gives police laboratories posi-tive proof even when there are only small traces of residue metals. The test uses an electron mi-croscope to identify the shapes of residue particles and an X-ray analyzer to determine the presence of gunpowder metals —lead, hardum and antimetic
