
Dear Mr. Brown:

This is in reference to your letter dated August 24, 1976, to Mr. Jay Cochran, Jr., Assistant Director of the FBI Laboratory Division. This response is being handled by the Freedom of Information-Privacy Acts (FOIPA) Section since your inquiry pertains to documents furnished in regard to your previous FOIPA request.

As you have previously been advised, the FOIPA does not provide for interpretation of disclosed documents. It only provides for searching of an agency's records to locate documents. We have provided you with all known documents pertaining to this matter.

As you were advised in my letter dated September 17, 1976, the testimonies of the FBI Agents who conducted these examinations are printed in the "Hearing Before the President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy." The testimony of Special Agent Robert A. Frazier may help to answer your questions.
