Dear Dr. Rhoads:

I am transmitting by means of this letter copies of the four lists of Warren Commission records requested by Congresswoman Bella Abzug, Chairwoman of the Government Information and Individual Rights Subcommittee of the House Committee on Government Operations. The lists have been reviewed by the component in the CIA with subject matter responsibility. Officers of that component have bracketed in red those words and phrases which they regard as currently sensitive from the standpoint of intelligence sources and methods. It is requested that the bracketed material be excised from both the handwritten and typewritten versions of the lists prior to submission to Congresswoman Abzug. We also recommend that you reconsider the question of whether the lists should be classified.

Pursuant to our prior agreement with Mr. Marion Johnson, we will forward a copy of the letter from Lawrence R. Houston to you, dated 22 December 1972, directly to Ms. Abzug.
