## MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME WITHIN WHICH TO OPPOSE DEFEN-DANT'S MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

Plaintiff respectfully moves the Court for an Order extending the time within which to oppose defendant's motion for summary judgment to May 8, 1976. In support thereor, plaintiff represents to the Court as follows:

Plaintiff's counsel believes that he will be able to file plaintiff's opposition within a day or two after the signing WHEREFORE, for the above-stated reasons, plaintiff requests that the Court enter an Order extending the time within which to oppose defendant's motion for summary judgment until May 8, 1976.
