The White House announcement of Executive Order 11652 was later ^{on} the day of my last listed letter.

My letters include a request for citation of the authority to classify under Executive Order 10501. This request was not responded to. Respondent had commemorated the fifth anniversary of this assassination by claiming the authority to withhold under Executive order 10501.

It is from the foregoing facts ^{did} apparent that I did make earlier requests; that my requests were denied under Executive Order 10501; my request for a review of this authority that does not in fact exist was ignored; and that I was denied these transcripts at a much earlier date than was represented as my first to this Court; and that the denial of my request was without sanction of law or executive order.
