MOTION TO SHORTEN TIME FOR RESPONDING TO
PLAINTIFF'S REQUEST FOR PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS


Comes now the plaintiff, Mr. Harold Weisberg, and moves the Court for an order requiring defendant to respond within 15 days from the date of service to the Request for Production of Documents which plaintiff filed and served on defendant on September 13, 1979.

This motion is made pursuant to Rule 34(b), which permits the District Court to enlarge or shorten the time for response. In support of his motion, plaintiff represent's to the Court as follows:

1. The request for production of documents is relatively simple, so it should be possible for the GSA to compile the requested documents and make them available to plaintiff within 15 days.
2. Plaintiff has noted depositions in this case for October 10, 1979. In order to properly prepare for those depositions, it is necessary that these records be obtained by plaintiff's counsel a few days in advance of the scheduled depositions.
3. Plaintiff's counsel will be leaving the country on October 20, 1979, for a month's vacation at his wife's home in Singa-

pore. Plaintiff would like to complete any discovery necessary to resolve the attorneys' fees issue before his counsel leaves for Singapore if it is at all possible to do so.


