## OPPOSITION TO DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR AN ENLARGEMENT OF TIME

By order dated October 17, 1979, this Court directed that "Defendant shall file any supplemental affidavits in support of its Opposition to Plaintiff's Motion for Attorney's Fees on or before November 21, 1979." On November 21st defendant moved for an additional two weeks extension of time, to and including December 5, 1979. No justification was given for this request, except for the statement that "[t]he agency has requested additional time in order to properly prepare the affidavit."

Plaintiff filed his motion for an award of attorney's fees on April 24, 1979. Thus defendant has had more than seven months in which to file an adequate affidavit in support of its claim that plaintiff has not "substantially prevailed" in this lawsuit. This continues the pattern of delays which defendant has engaged in throughtout this litigation. For this reason, plaintiff opposes the enlargement requested by defendant.

In addition, plaintiff notes that by order filed October 25, 1979, the Court of Appeals denied defendant's motion for reconsideration of the award of costs which the Court had made to plain-

tiff and amended its original award of costs to increase the amount to be taxed against defendant. Plaintiff submits that the Court's order resolves the issue of whether he has "substantially prevailed" in this litigation, rendering any further showing by the defendant on this issue superfluous. (A copy of the Court of Appeals' October 25, 1979 order is attached.
