After a delay of more than six months, I have just received your Deputy's letter dated June 13 which does not respond to my requests of December 15, 1951.

Under the circumstances, and particularly because of the importance being in issue, I believe, a violation of 5 U.S.C. 552, I regard this arrangement as a violation and I write this letter to you as my appeal from it.
