I want to add something to what I said in spontaneous reaction. When you can I would like you to pass it along.

I don't give a damn what these people say and want us to believe. My only interest is in what they do. And, of course, do not do.

They are. like most people in office, power mad. Those with power mad in use of it, those without power mad from those who use it.

They do dirty, disreputable things. Because they do them and because they speak and act for the government what is right is what they do, not what is right to normal people. There is no wrong for them.

I can't imagine Lynne as a lawyer in private practise pulling some of the things she has pulled in this.

(Some of them have to have lied to "etsy incherg or she is a liar in her sum sight because she lied today. She said I have given them nothing. I have given them much, including copies of records.)

Tell them for me they have a lesson ceming. In time and in mency and in a form they'll never formet.

They have been party to all these dirty tricks for three years now. They have taken three years of what life I have left, what work I have left. If I have to take it out of their lives to obtain the return of what remains of mine place given them to understand that they will be so tied up in court and in appeals and in complaints that they'll all want to quit. I'll protest every withholding I can protest immediate and in writing. I'll protest every empirical the same way. They'll go crasy on 'augh v Rosen inventories.

They want to chisel on fees? If they succeed it will cost them more money because they'll be spending more of their time.

I'm going to go furthur. I'm going to start making records of all the false swearings, all the misrepresentations and deception and if I have to I'm going to seek redress.

If I can t get anything do for the dirty things they do I'll do the right things, these I have not been doing, and take up all their time.

I don't know but I think, if they go through with this, that I'll start with Aboureak. These people know that they represent the prosscutor so they say anything, even under oath. I'll show they lied under eath, that they misrepresented to the Congress.

All the things I've let go I'da not let go again.

If they want it their way they sure as hell are going to get it their way.

Tall lyame of do not tall her. The one thing you can be sure I'll have done before next Veinesday is collecting the proof that she never teld a single truthful thing to Judge "reen.
