Dear Jim,

This is right after your call in which you gave me Lynne's latest explanations, if that is what they are.

I want to add something to what I said in spontaneous reaction. When you can I would like you to pass it along.

I don't give a damn what these people say and want us to believe. My only interest is in what they do. And, of course, do not do.

They are. like most people in office, power mad. Those with power mad in use of it, those without power mad from those who use it.

They do dirty, disreputable things. Because they do them and because they speak and act for the government what is right is what they do, not what is right to normal people. There is no wrong for them.

I can't imagine Lynne as a lawyer in private practise pulling some of the things she has pulled in this.

(Some of them have to have lied to Metay Ineberg or she is a liar in her own right because she lied today. She said I have given them nothing. I have given them much, including copies of records.)

Tell them for me they have a lesson coming. In time and in money and in a form they'll never forget.

They have been party to all these dirty tricks for three years now. They have taken three years of what life I have left, what work I have left. If I have to take it out of their lives to obtain the return of what remains of mine please given them to understand that they will be so tied up in court and in appeals and in complaints that they'll all want to quit. I'll protest every withholding I can protest immediate and in writing. I'll protest every excision the same way. They'll go crazy on Vaughn v Rosen inventories.

They want to chisel on fees? If they succeed it will cost them more money because they'll be spending more of their time.

I'm going to go farther. I'm going to start making records of all the false swearings, all the misrepresentations and deception and if I have to I'm going to seek redress.

If I can't get anything done for the dirty things they do I'll do the right things, those I have not been doing, and take up all their time.

I don't know but I think, if they go through with this, that I'll start with Abuseusk. These people know that they represent the prosecutor so they say anything, even under oath. I'll show they lied under oath, that they misrepresented to the Congress.

All the things I've let go I'll not let go again.

If they want it their way they sure as hell are going to get it their way.

Tell Lynne of do not tell her. The one thing you can be sure I'll have done before next Wednesday is collecting the proof that she never told a single truthful thing to Judge Green. They want to go up on appeal? Tell her and Schaeffer the kind of record on which they are going to go up on appeal. Tell them that if they want to advertise the kinds of miserable people they have been I'll give them all the advertising of which I am capable, including a record of persisting in filing false affidavits.

In the fall of 1976 I told Judge Green that this case would not end, unless capitulated, as long as there was no punishment for misrepresentations. I'm going back to that and prove all over again what I alleged then. They'll be happy with their appeal. ...Lynne also was trying to blackmail you on the fee bit. Best,
