Dear Quin,

In this morning's mail and dated today I have a letter from Allen McCreight enclosing a check for a refund of \$2,742.60 of fees related to King records.

My wife's records do not in all cases show the FOIA purposes for which FOIA checks were issued. We also paid from two accounts, one here and one for Jim Oscar's use in Washington.

Am I correct in believing that the refund was to include JFK assassination records also?

We also issued checks to the Department, separately from to the FBI.

The FBI appear to have regarded the records provided under C.A. 75-1996 as two different cases. I amended the complaint.

In her review of the checks issued my wife comes up with about \$400 not refunded by the FBI for the period beginning 2/11/77.

My first King ^{REV} payments to the FBI were in early 1976. Some search fees were included.

There may be some simple explanation for the discrepancy.

I would appreciate it if you could get the entire matter cleared up for all components.

Thanks for anything you can do.
