HE STATED HE HAD MADE CERTAIN SUGGESTIONS FOR IMPROVING SECURITY AT THE SHELBY COUNTY.

THE FORM OF SUGGESTIONS TO LOCAL AUTHORITIES HAD BEEN DISCUSSED BY HIM WITH AAG FRED VINSON IN WASHINGTON, D.C. DURING COURSE OF CONVERSATION, STATED AAG VINSON HAD TOLD HIM THAT IT APPEARED THAT THE EARLIEST ANY POSSIBLE ACTION MIGHT BE TAKEN INSOFAR AS EXTRADITION OF RAY FROM ENGLAND WOULD BE ON OR ABOUT JULY THIRTEEN, NEXT. STATED HE THOUGHT AAG VINSON MIGHT BE OPTIMISTIC IN REGARD TO THIS DATE.

COUNTY SO INDICATED THAT IT MIGHT BE ADVISABLE FOR ADDITIONAL
PERSONNEL-TYPE INVESTIGATIONS TO BE CONDUCTED RE DUPUTIES WHO
MIGHT BE ENTRUSTED TO CARE AND PROTECTION OF PRISONER RAY. HE
MADE TENTATIVE INQUIRY AS TO POSSIBILITY OF FBI CONDUCTING
SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS OF THIS TYPE. WAS TOLD BY SAC THAT
INVESTIGATIONS OF THIS TYPE WERE NOT CONDUCTED BY FBI. IT WAS
SUGGESTED TO THAT SINCE PRIME RESPONSIBILITY FOR PROTECTION

HE ALSO SAID THAT UNDER BRITISH LAW, REPORTEDLY A PRISONER MUST HAVE TWO HOURS OF EXERCISE ON A DAILY BASIS. DURING THE EXERCISE PERIOD OF RAY, WAS TOLD THE EXERCISE YARD IS CLEARED OF ALL PERSONNEL AND THE BRITISH AUTHORITIES DO HAVE SECURITY DOGS ON HAND IN THE EVENT OF ANY PROBLEMS ARISING.
