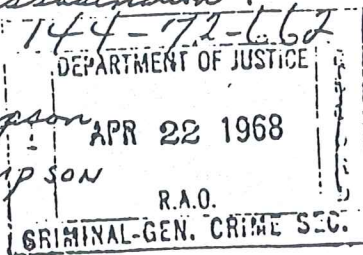

closely..

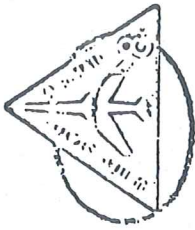
