11. Cousin is allegedly an ex-Marine and according to doesn't like the cousin, stating "he is rotten". Apparently felt relieved after the cousin couldn't make it to Memphis. Tenn., on 18 March 1968, even though, according to is in financial distress. According to cousin is "well off financially", he seldom aces his cousin, and the unidentified distant cousin reportedly travels extensively.

12. On completion of interview, was administered an oath in accordance with SECNAV INST. 55201 of 1; June 1959 and verbelly attested to the truthfulness of his comments. He declared that he would be willing to appear for testimony at any subsequent legal proceedings.

13. At 0015 hours, 6 April 1968, Special Agent Relph J. LIEVER, FBI, Memphis, Tenn., was apprised of the information and advised that the information would be evaluated relative to further pursuit by the FBI.

14. On Saturday, 6 April 1968, Special Agent "Cy" BUSH, FBI, advised the undersigned that the FBI would undertake further interview of relative to the above matter. In view of the foregoing no additional action or referral is anticipated by this office.
