AFFIDAVIT OF JAMES H. LESAR

- I, James H. Lesar, first having been duly sworn, hereby depose and say as follows:
- 1. I represent the plaintiff in the above-entitled cause of action.
- 2. By letter dated June 8, 1978, Mr. Allen H. McCreight, then Chief, Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts Branch, Record Management Division, Federal Bureau of Investigation, advised Mr. Harold Weisberg, the plaintiff herein, that: "CIA documents located in FBI files which relate to the Assassination of Dr. King have been returned to that agency for their direct response to you." (See Attachment 1, p. 3)
- 3. Attachment 2 to this affidavit is a list of those FBI Headquarters "MURKIN" records said to have been referred to the CIA which Mr. Weisberg believes still remain withheld from him. Seven of the ten referrals listed are said by the FBI to have been referred to the CIA on March 17, 1977, more than three years ago.
- 4. On Wednesday, April 9, 1980, I conferred by phone with Mr. Weisberg and his assistant, Ms. Rae Barrett, about these CIA referrals. They advised me that to the best of their knowledge and belief Mr. Weisberg has never received the "direct response" from

the CIA promised in Mr. McCreight's letter to Mr. Weisberg of June 8, 1978. Mr. Weisberg further advised me that the abstracts of "MURKIN" records which he has received show that these CIA referrals remain withheld, and that he has made a number of appeals to Mr. Quinlan J. Shea, Jr., Director, Office of Information and Privacy Appeals, U.S. Department of Justice, protesting the delay in acting upon these referrals.

- 5. The Freedom of Information Act was intended to secure prompt access to government information. It has now been more than three years since most of these records were referred to the Central Intelligence Agency, yet they remain withheld.
- 6. The government has the burden of showing that withheld information falls within a specific exemption to the general rule of disclosure mandated by the Freedom of Information Act. In this case the government has not even made a claim of exemption for these CIA referrals, much less shown that they are entitled to be withheld from the public.


