

NOTICE OF CLARIFICATION

Upon receipt of a copy of the Memorandum to the Court which was filed on August 20, 1980, plaintiff has expressed to his counsel the need to clarify what was written with respect to New Orleans field office file No. 157-10673 at pages 3-4 of the Memorandum. 
