Attached relates on afternoon of 4-3-72, Robert P. Smith, who identified himself as being associated with Committee to Investigate Assassinations, Washington, D. C., telephonically requested interview of Agent of our Dallas Office to discuss various aspects of assassination of President Kennedy. Smith was advised this matter could not be discussed with him and he was referred to the Department of Justice.

Bureau files characterize the Committee to Investigate Assassinations as a group which believes that a conspiracy existed in the assassination of President Kennedy, Martin Luther King, and Robert Kennedy. Members of this committee have attempted unsuccessfully to obtain information under the Freedom of Information Act.
