OF GALT WAS IN THE NEWSPAPER.

[REDACTED] FURTHER ADVISED THAT AT APPROXIMATELY TEN AM ON APRIL TWELVE A WHITE MALE AGE EARLY THIRTIES, FIVE FEET SEVEN INCHES, ONE FIFTYFIVE TO SIXTY POUNDS, MEDIUM BUILD, DARK BROWN HAIR, FAIR COMPLEXION, CLEAN SHAVEN, APPEARED AT HIS STORE. [REDACTED] SAID THE UNKNOWN MALE WAS WEARING A DARK OLIVE GREEN SUMMER WEIGHT SUIT, WHITE SHIRT AND NO TIE. HE SAID THAT HE COULD NOT FURNISH ANY ADDITIONAL PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OR OF THE CLOTHING THE UNKNOWN MALE WAS WEARING.

[REDACTED] ADVISED UNKNOWN MALE PURCHASED THE FOLLOWING ITEMS AND PAID FOR THEM WITH TWO AMERICAN TEN DOLLAR BILLS:

ONE PAIR OF SLACKS, COMBED COTTON ANTELOPE COLOR WAIST THIRTYFOUR, LENGTH TWENTYNINE WITH LABEL ON INSIDE WAISTBAND [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] NIAGARA FALLS, ONTARIO."

ON SPORT SHIRT DESCRIBED AS HAVING IMITATION SUEDE FRONT. LONG BLACK CLOTH SLEEVES BLACK CLOTH TURTLE NECK WITH ZIPPER UP THE FRONT. LABEL ON INSIDE IS "FLORIDA QUALITY KNITTING-MADE IN CANADA," NO CITY NOTED.

[REDACTED] SAID THAT UNKNOWN MALE CHANGED INTO SLACKS

AND SPORT SHIRT IN THE STORE DRESSING ROOM. [REDACTED] OFFERED TO PUT HIS OTHER CLOTHES IN A BAG BUT UNKNOWN MALE REFUSED, ADVISING THAT HE WAS IN A HURRY AND THAT HE WOULD CARRY THEM. PRIOR TO UNKNOWN MALE'S DEPARTURE FROM THE STORE, HE ASKED FOR THE QUICKEST DIRECTION TO MONTREAL, CANADA.

[REDACTED] TOLD HIM TO TAKE THE QUEEN ELIZABETH WAY, QEW, TO ROUTE TWENTYSEVEN NORTH TO TORONTO FOUR ZERO ONE E FROM TORONTO TO MONTREAL. [REDACTED] ASSUMES UNKNOWN MALE HAD CAR BUT SAW NONE. INVESTIGATION IN SHOPPING AREA ADJACENT TO [REDACTED] FAILS TO REVEAL ADDITIONAL PURCHASES BY UNKNOWN MALE.

DRESSING ROOM SEARCH FAILS TO REVEAL ANY EVIDENCE LEFT BY UNKNOWN MALE.

BRIDGES LEADING FROM US TO CANADA AND NIAGARA FALLS AREA UNABLE TO ESTABLISH CROSSING OF VEHICLES AS NO RECORD KEPT OF VEHICLES CROSSING INTO CANADA BY CANADIAN AUTHORITIES.

CANADIAN AUTHORITIES IN NIAGARA FALLS AND BUFFALO AREA ALERTED FOR POSSIBLE RETURN TO AREA BY UNKNOWN MALE.

LEGAT, OTTAWA ALERT APPROPRIATE AUTHORITIES AT

MONTREAL.
