I, Thomas F. Conley, having been duly sworn, do  
hereby depose and say:


1. I am the Chief of the Freedom of Information/  
Privacy Office, United States Army Intelligence and  
Security Command (hereinafter INSCOM), United States Army.

a. Pursuant to Army Regulation 340-17, 32 C.F.R.  
518, the Deputy Commander, INSCOM, was designated the Initial  
Denial Authority to act on requests submitted pursuant to  
the Freedom of Information Act (hereinafter FOIA) involving  
Army intelligence investigative records. The Deputy Commander,  
INSCOM, delegated this function to the Chief of the Freedom of  
Information/Privacy Office.


b. The matters stated herein are based upon my  
personal review and consideration of information available to  
me in my official capacity.

2. By letter dated 5 January 1978, the Central  
Intelligence Agency (hereinafter CIA) referred to the Office  
of The Adjutant General, Department of the Army, one Army  
document discovered in CIA files in connection with a FOIA  
request plaintiff had made to the CIA. By letter dated 10  
January 1978, this document was referred to Chief of the  
Freedom of Information/Privacy Office, INSCOM, for appropriate  
action.

3. By letter dated 17 January 1978, the document was released in its entirety to the plaintiff.
