I, RALPH MERITHE CARPENTER, being duly sworn,  
depose and say:

1. On April 4, 1958, I was employed as a salesman  
at the York Arms Company, located at 162 South Main Street,  
Memphis, Tennessee.

2. At approximately 4:00p.m. on the afternoon of  
April 4, 1958, a man entered the store and stated that he  
wished to purchase some binoculars. I obtained for him a  
pair of 7 by 35 Bushnell binoculars from the display window  
in the front of the store. The total cost of the binoculars,  
together with a leather or similar type carrying case, was  
\$41.50.

3. The store does not record or maintain serial  
numbers for these binoculars, and I do not know what, if  
any, serial number was on these binoculars.

4. On April 16, 1958, I was visited by two agents  
of the Federal Bureau of Investigation who exhibited to me  
the photographs of five men. After studying the photographs  
carefully, I placed my name on the back of the photograph  
which I felt most resembled the man who bought the set of  
binoculars from me on April 4, 1958. I was not furnished  
any name or any descriptive data regarding the photographs  
shown. Attached as Exhibit I is a photograph which is  
identical to the one I identified on April 16, 1958.

5. I have re-examined this photograph and reaffirm today my identification of it.
