SUBJECT

- REPORT FROM

1. A called me this morning at the office to thank me

2. A advised that - C was not in evidence following the assassination of Martin Luther KING on Thursday, 4 April 1968. A received word from a reliable source that PDC, who is under Peking discipline, was instructed not to be in the forefront.

A and other leaders in the Black Power structure who are under Peking discipline will hold a strategy meeting in the Reverend KING's home after the funeral.

3. A suggested that - C will disclose that PDC and A will be in the forefront during the funeral services. According to A has sufficient information of a blackmail nature on - C that will result in - C reacting as a puppet to Peking direction in the coming presidential nominating campaign. A urged that a task force be established not by the FBI but by the intelligence community to cover - C from now on in which should develop the intelligence that - C, Martin Luther KING, and - C have for years been the willing tools of Peking.
