JL - One of the King files, as I ~~now~~ recall ~~Heever's, not,~~ CIA's, refers to him in a way suggesting that he visited 3267 N St., NW in 1966. I do not think it is worth taking time to go to the library to check but if among the old city directories you obtained there is one covering 1966 it might be worth the time to check and see ~~me~~ who lived there then. Conspicuously absent in what the CIA has given us is any record relating to any one of these records on where he was when and with whom. It is not at all probable that it collected all these trivialities, including what he bought at what men's shop, his motel bills, etc., without some kind of correlation with the names, particularly of the several women mentioned. Nor is it likely, given the CIA's knowledge of the FBI's interest in such personal details, that the CIA did not let it know about these expenses and other personal records it obtained.
