

A confidential informant of known reliability has adviced as follows regarding the relationship between the Director of the FBI and the Rov Martin Luther King:

He asked for time to think the matter over and said he would see The following day. He did not appear as promised and later that King had gone to Washington and made his peace with the Director FBI.
