JL - Gene Wilson's 3/23/70 is atonewalling, dishonest and a new effort to create a false/record. While I could have ignored it because I have already addressed everything he says I believe it was better to make a record of his effort at dirty tricks and to reiterate that I had offered to pay for these 14,375 records if he insists, subject to sy right to recover the charge. I am refusing to permit any disposition of that 5500 because he makes these belated efforts only when that is before a court. His effort to most by trick is a little too obvious.

That he would make such efforts, beging in one case with long-overius compliance and in the other with equally long overdue beginning of processing only after I've filed suit makes a record we can use in court.

I remind you for the King case that the CIA has not processed any one of the many MURKIN records forwarded to it by DV/FSI going back about a year and a half.

I also remind you that what he calls the drug/behavioral medification records are directly related to the Warren Commission, the JFK investigation and to Cauald and on this gound alone were initially of interest to me. I found a report in which behave was sufficiently skilled in accantics to luli all others into ignoring it. The Warren Commission, among others, was interested in this in connection with its investigation, leading to the less than fully informative behave semerandom I obtained from the Commission's files.
