

CIA-FOIA-JFK

Allegation of obly "good faith" in Motion.

It is not only that the CIA has not complied with my all-inclusive JFK request, the request it misuses to refuse compliance on selective smaller subjects.

It refuses to comply after providing records to others.

One that came to mind is the Mickey Levy suit vs. Secret Service, before Gesell.

Much of that was CIA records the Secret Service referred to the CIA, after which they were okayed for the SS to give Levy.

The CIA has not even offered me those records after more than a year.

Also evidence of official good faith is the fact that all of what Levy got and more is included in my over-all JFK request of the Secret Service. It has not acted on my appeal and it has not even offered me the records it gave Levy.

There is no presumption of good faith in an FOIA case because if there were the presumption there would be no need for the Act, as the legislative history establishes.

There is no evidence cited in the Motion because there is no such evidence of good faith in this case. I've given you memo on this in the past. I add the Levy one because it just came to mind.
