On several eccasions on that afternoon I heard footsteps in room 5-B and also heard footsteps leaving room 5-B and going past my room and into the common bathroom at the east and of the hell. I was very such aware that when the person went from room 5-B to the bethroom, he remained in the bathroom for a considerable period of time. This was particularly noticeable because this is a common bethroom which must be used by a member of different tenents .
