
Dear Mr. Shea:

As the enclosed copy of my letter to the Attorney General states, Mr. Lesar phoned me last night to read to me excerpts from your most recent abandonment of common decency.

I have asked Mr. Lesar to seek to subpoena you to testify under oath to those unspeakable lies and defamations because I believe they are relevant to what will be before the court. I also believe that if you swear to what you have written, you will swear falsely to the material.

I also want you and the Attorney General to know that I have arranged for a press conference for 2:30 p.m. Monday, January 16th, in the Presidential Room of the National Press Club. I invite you to get your face out from behind those official skirts that you personally soil.
