ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, NOVEMBER 22, 1963, DALLAS, TEXAS

SA THOMAS W. CRAWFORD conducted the following investigation at Brownsville, Texas, in an effort to identify LEE HARVEY OSWALD as possibly traveling out of New Orleans, Louisiana, for Mexico, via Brownsville, Texas, on a <u>Continental Bus leaving New Orleans</u>, Louisiana, at 6 a.m., September 15, 1963. Such bus would regularly arrive at Brownsville 6:15 a.m., September 16, 1963.

Continental Bus Depot personnel, Brownsville, Texas, and cab drivers shown below with date interviewed said they regularly attended arrival of Continental Bus from New Orleans 6:15 a.m., September 16, 1963, here. They said they knew suspect OSWALD from news media.

None could recall seeing OSWALD on September 16, 1963, at any time.

MANUEL GARCIA, Ticket Agent, Brownsville, Continental Bus upper on December 1, 1963, provided the complete restruction list for September 16, 1963, continued travel. All the reservations were for Mexico City and were by Transportes del Norte Bus Line. Each was in handwriting of the seat holder, according to Mr. GARCIA.
