She had been raised in Columbus, Ohio. She and are
both members of the Young Friends Movement, which is an
organization anxious to do something to aid the relaxation of
East-West tensions. They are active in getting pen pals and
encouraging personal contacts with people on both sides of the
Iron Curtain. They also have formed small study groups to
become conversant with Russian culture and folkways.

According to RUTH HYDE married PAINE about six years ago and subsequently moved to Dallas, Tex. She can speak Russian but has never been to Russia, as far as knows. He said LEE OSWALD and his wife got in touch with PAINE through the pen pal program of the Young Friends Movement. He said LEE OSWALD had never been to Philadelphia.

RUTH PAINE he did not know OSWALD, nor the situation in Dallas relative to the OSWALD family and Mrs. PAINE.
