Mrs. ARTHUR M. YOUNG, 1810 Delancey Place, advised she and her former husband, GEORGE LYMAN PAINE, JR., were divorced in the winter of 1933-1934, after she established six weeks' residence in Virginia City, Nev.

As a result of this divorce, she was given the custody of MICHAEL RALPH PAINE, their son. She said when her son was a small child he spent ten days with his paternal grand-parents and she could recall no other association between the father and son until the father attended the wedding of the son about six years ago.

She said her son, MICHAEL, was a reluctant letter writer and she doubted there was much correspondence between father and son.

On December 19, 1963, Mrs. YOUNG telephonically contacted SA JOHN R. WINEBERG and stated she had talked to her daughter-in-law, RUTH PAINE, the evening of December 18, 1963, and RUTH PAINE advised that MICHAEL PAINE's father had visited the PAINEs on one occasion several years ago when the PAINES lived in Texas. She also said MICHAEL PAINE visited his father over a weekend while they have been in Texas.
