## MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

This case arises under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552. Only one document is at issue. The defendants contend that the document is properly withheld from public inspection pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(1), (b)(2) and (b)(3). The matter is before the Court on defendants' motion to dismiss.

The requested document has previously been described in a Vaughn v Rosen [484 F.2d 820 (D.C. Cir. 1973)] index filed in Bernard Fensterwald v CIA, Civil Action No. 75-0897 (D.D.C. 1978) (Sirica, J.). This Court held that the document was protected from disclosure. In addition, the appropriate office in the CIA has re-reviewed the document in question in light of the new, more stringent, criteria set forth in Executive Order 12065, effective December 1, 1978, and has determined that the material is classified at the SECRET level and should be withheld from disclosure. Agency affidavits concerning the classification of documents are entitled to "substantial weight." Adele Halkin v Helms, Nos. 77-1922 and 77-1923 (D.C. Cir. June 16, 1978).
