All of what is now 7627 Old Receiver Road disclosed, with the possible exception of the name of the guard at the USSR Major City Embassy, is in those records. Dallas and New Orleans records, which I obtained in C.A. 75-0322 and 9420 and have read. I obtained and read all of those records prior to the 3/79 status call in Allen's case. Moreover, all of this also was investigated and published by the Schweiker subcommittee of the Senate's Church committee, whose life ended long before this status call. It withheld Alvarad's name but that was readily available in the Commission's records and in my files prior to its existence. In addition, the repeated disclosure of the existence of a CIA Mexico station refutes the CIA's sworn (and disputed) representations that even where the existence of a CIA station is known it must not be confirmed officially because to do so would endanger the national defense. Mark Allen called last night about a development in his case. He had learned that the government had released part of the document he is seeking but he had not yet received it. I picked up the attached copy of it this morning. I did not have time to xerox the Owen and Briggs affidavits which were submitted along with it. Smith has set a hearing on motions in the case for next week. Not clear if Smith intends to include summary judgment motion which Govt. told Allen it will file later this week.
