Unreliable "information" in the catagory of unverifiable rumor and speculation on informant's part. Informant stated that several weeks ago he talked with BUND! who is a fellow prisoner and the person who testified that he saw CLAY SHAW pass money to someone at the Lake front. BUNDY indicated that he had been offered a deal by GARRISON if he would testify to a story about SHAW. This supposedly took place several weeks ago in Parish Prison and before BUDY testified. BUDY was undecided but told informant and others that he would do anything to get out of his sentence. BUNDY indicated in so many words without coming out and Stating directly that his testimony was not true and a story given to him to tell. Informent further advised he has been approached by SALVATORE PANZECA and BOB WILSON (former Agent) with respect to testifying to this on behalf of CIAY SHAW. PANZECA is a member of the firm representing SHAW. Informant further stated that in about January, 1967 INNI LOUSEL. down Dauphine Street and pointed out member of GARFISON's staffdre a white house with a red door and asked him as he could get into the house and out and put something in it without being detected. Informant declined and was told that it had something to do with the KENLEDY assasination and that the residence was that of SHAW. Informant Was not told what he was to do In the house or place in the house. He was given the DA office confidential number of 822 2184. This was changed and he was given the present number of 822-0584 through which he could contact the DA. Informent furnished the above information on his own volition and and asked nothing in return. "This material is Zerox copies of letters that were found by NOPD Officer RAYMOND COMSTOCK whend he conducted a search without a warrant of FERRIE's residence while attempting to arrest FERRIE. These letters outline various strategh and investigation conducted by MARCELLO's attorneys in connection with the trial of MARCELLO at NO. It is known that FERRIE was in Guatemala during the month of October, 1963 and possibly early November, 1963; and FERRIE was closely associated with the MARCELLO attorney at the time of the trial of MARCELLO at NO.

The lA envelope which once contained the copies of the above material has a notation of 5/17/67 that the copies were furnished the USA by SA CARNEY and SA KENNEDY.



On February 13, 1954, Raymond Constock, New Orleans Police officer assigned to the District Attorney's office, advised that shortly after the assassination of President John F. Menuedy he was conducting an investigation to locate David W. Ferrie who was alleged to have been an associate of Lee Harvey Oswald. In connection with this investigation he attempted to locate Ferrie at his residence and in the course of his investigation at Ferrie's residence, 3020 Louisiana Avenue Darkway, he found the following material:

Two undated letters addressed to Mr. Jack

signed D. M. Ferrie, bearing the return address

Ir. Comstock advised that this material was obtained without a varrant and the search was not conducted incidental to an arrest as Ferrie was not present at his residence and was not located until several days subsequent to his investigation at this address. Ir. Constock advised that he made copies of above material which he made available on February 13, *984.





- 1. The Board of Directors was looking for a chairman who enjoys some prestige. Former Senator Thomas Dodd, of Connecticut, was briefly considered for the role.
- The committee had been turned down for tax exempt status.
- 3. The committee's bank account balance was \$365.00.
- 4. Senator Ted Kennedy was described as "brutally opposed to what we are doing."
- 5. Committee members believe that a conspiracy existed in the assassination of President Kennedy, Rev. Martin Luther King, Senator Robert Kennedy, and they also questioned the circumstances of the recent death in Nigeria, an apparent reference to the drowning death of Whitney Young, former head of the Urban League, who was attended on that occasion by for er Attorney General Ramsey Clark.

committee members would be interested in having Special Agent James P. Hosty, of the Kansas City Office, furnish information to one of their members which they assume he has withheld concerning the "true relationship" between Lee Harvey Oswald and the Bureau.

members are interested in certain investigative reports of Special Agent Robert P. Gemberling, of the Dallas Office, (referred to as Bob Gimberly) some of whose reports concerning the assassination of President Kennedy were not published by the Warren Committee.

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It is suggested that the Kansas City and Dallas Offices alert SA's HOSTY and GEMBERLING to the fact that they might be approached by individuals acting on behalf of captioned committee.

It is the evaluation of this office that the captioned committee is composed of a number of anti-establishment paranoids with an innate distruct of our system of government.

The enclosure is forwarded only for the information of the Bureau, and no action is recommended.





Envid W. Ferrie is a former pilot for Enstern Airlines and according to impsend Constock is a notorious homosexual in the City of New Orleans. Ferris was observed during the course of the trial of Carlos harcello curing the month of hovember, 1000, to be in trequent contact with defense attorneys G. Wray Gill and Jack hasserman. Gill and hasserman were Carlos Enroellos principal defense attorneys.

Favid W. Ferrie when interviewed by New Orleans FBI Agents in connection with another investigation on Movember 25, 1963, admitted that he has been employed by Attorney G. Fray Gill since Parch, 1983, and sumitted working from August, 1983 to November, 1983 on the case involving Carlos Surrello who has been charmed in Federal Court in connection with a fraugulent Firth certificate.

Ferrie admitted visiting Guatemala on October 11, 1983, and departing Guatemala October 18, 1983, and entering Guatemala on October 19, 1983, and experting November 1, 1983. This internation is continued by U. 3. Presport number E035360 that Ferrie exhibited when using interviewed by Lureau agents on another matter on november 25, 1883.

I id U. Ferrie is identical with New Orleans Police Department number 107006. He was born in Cleveland, Chio, on warch 28, 1013, is S'll", weighs 185 pounds. He is hald and wears a home-wade wig. Ferrie's police Department record does not reflect a conviction.
