Dear Harold:

Enclosed are Zapruder's letter to me of November 19th and the agreement which he signed after modifying it. The first change provides that the copyright notice "shall be displayed upon each showing of the Zapruder film." The second change simply adds the phrase "and his assigns" after your name in the second numbered paragraph.

I see no reason to object to these changes if you don't.

Zapruder seems confused about what you have in mind with the original film; he seems to imply, although he does not say so directly, that the original is with him rather than the Archives. Perhaps it might help if you spell it out in a letter to him to be sent through me. Frankly, I thought what we have in mind was clear enough in what I wrote him earlier. Does what you have in mind require that the film be taken out of the possession of the Archives (or whoever has the original) and then returned?
