
ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion to Compel Defendant to answer his request for admissions is denied. It is further

ORDERED that within 30 days of the date of this Order, defendant shall serve upon plaintiff and file with the Court answers to Interrogatories 12(a), 32, and 33. It is further

ORDERED that plaintiff shall serve upon defendant and file with the Court responsive answers to defendant's interrogatories and request for production of documents, providing

finally his contentions concerning the adequacy of the FBI search, within 30 days from the date of this Order. See Weisberg v. U. S. Dept. of Justice, No. 82-1072, slip. op. at 17-19 n. 12 (D. C. Cir. April 5, 1983). It is further

ORDERED that defendant shall submit an affidavit within 10 days from the date of this Order, detailing the expenses, including attorney's fees, which were incurred in obtaining the Order compelling plaintiff to answer interrogatories and produce documents.
