When Greg Stone was here earlier this week he gave me a copy of an ~~NARS~~ report to ~~John~~ Harold Greene on the FBI's records practises and destructions. I'm about half-way through it and stopped to be at my desk to spot Lil when she returns from grocery shopping with a friend, so I can carry the groceries in. My purposes in writing you before I complete the reading and writing of a ~~memo~~ ^{memo} (which the Maryland game will preclude today) is to alert you to the potential importance of this official but non-FBI document in FOIA cases. I am marking passages with paperclips and will make copies of those pages for comment. It is apparent that the FBI's lying in both my King and JFK cases is wholesale and not accidental. And on this I call to your attention that once again I have the appearance of Merlin, which someone once said, in that as I said it would, the FBI's and other official lying would be attracting attention. See today's Post's story on the DJ's lying about EPA, for example, to the Congress and to the courts, and on EPA's lying, too.

I'll inform Mark Lynch's office, in the event they have not seen this report.

Greg was very effective in his seminar in Gerry McKnight's class, he tells me. The students reacted well and kept him longer than planned and some of them kept him ~~me~~ busy with questions after the seminar ended.

The title is, "Appraisal of the Records of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, A Report to Hon. Harold H. Greene..." by ~~NARS~~ NARS, 11/9/81.



P.S. How could the joint team that went to Dallas examine its JFK assassination holdings which had been transferred to FBIHQ years earlier and supposedly remain there because of ongoing litigation? Report says they did.

This report confirms just about everything I attested to in 0322/0420 with regard to where the FBI has records outside the central files/index and how there is special filing/nonfiling and where.
