This old man may be biting official dogs this coming Tuesday, 12/10, in Courtroom 15, when there is a hearing on my motion to reconsider the Order on the judgement against me, under FOIA yet, with the only issues, as I see it (and I'm not a lawyer), my undenied allegations that the judgement was procured by fraud, misrepresentation and perjury. Yes, Judge Smith's error on not making any Findings of Fact, as required by the Rules.

You may recall the documentation attached to my earlier filings. I enclose the Response, which is the last filing in the case.

Alas, I'm pro se. But then I think that what I've done is rather dangerous for lawyers, who can be retaliated against, the reason I'm pro se - they created a conflict of interest between me and my lawyer.

I got the notice today. I've arranged transportation because I've not been able to drive out of Frederick for about eight years, I'll be in a wheelchair because I can walk ^{not} much and can't stand for more than a moment at a time, but I'll be there.

I wish I could think that NBC would want you there because of the importance of the underlying issues and the significance of an evil FOIA precedent if I do not prevail. Before this judge, I regard my chances as not very good, but I'll try and if I fail I'll appeal.
