Judge Smith is holding a hearing then on my motion to reconsider.


Just got the notice.

The underlying issues, however, are, I'm confident, quite important to freedom of information and the creation of extraordinary problem for requesters of information, if you've read what I've sent in the past.

If your associate is there I do not want my use of a wheelchair to mislead him. I need it for sitting rather than transportation. I can walk a city block almost all the time and sometimes two city blocks but I'm not permitted to stand for more than a moment.
