Dear Journalist/Counsellor,

The dog biting man aspect will, I hope, appeal to the journalist and the writer/FOIA requester charging criminal activity to DJ/FBI, may interest the lawyer in the hearing on my motion to reconsider, which I believe I sent you, before Judge J.L. Smith this coming Tuesday, 12/10, at 10:30 a.m., courtroom 15. (CA 78-0322/0420)

To now there is not even pro forma denial of my (I believe firmly) documented and proven charges of fraud, perjury and misrepresentation to defraud me of about three months of my Social Security, which is what the judgement procured against me means.


If you did not read or do not recall what I sent you earlier, DJ/FBI phoned up a spurious case against my lawyer in this and, while it was overturned, with the Nader law group representing him, it created a conflict of interest that leaves me without counsel and pro se.

As you may recall, I've not been able to drive to D.C. since 1977 but I've arranged for a friend to drive me and my wheelchair down and I'll be there unless weather prohibits it. (Medical restricts on which my life can depend.) I do not want to mislead you about the wheelchair, I can walk about a city block before I have to rest and elevate the leg leg but I am permitted to stand only briefly. My greater need for the wheelchair now is to avoid standing.

How concepts of news (and law and justice) has^{je} changed since my day! There has not been a word of attention to this truly outrageous business or to the truly evil precedents about to be created, which will hurt others, especially the media, more than me. If this had been done in my reporting days, if any official body had attempted such evil against an aged and ill man, the papers would have screamed. And lawyers would not be silent in the face of knowing and deliberate felonies by any agency, least of all those intended to enforce laws and assure justice.

I do hope that first^s you and then your desk agree that perhaps there is news in this situation in 1978 litigation - under a 10-day law. (I have a 1975 case that hasn't ended yet, thanks to government stonewalling.)
