MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
 IN WHICH TO FILE BRIEF FOR APPELLANT

Comes now the appellant, Mr. Harold Weisberg, and moves the Court for an extension of time to and including September 20, 1979 within which to file his brief in this case. In support of his motion, appellant represents to the Court as follows:
