DOCUMENT DISPOSITION INDEX

Preface

This Index will identify all CIA documents retrieved and reviewed for release in the Directorate of Operations of the CIA. A total of 207 documents (639 pages) have been retrieved and reviewed. Of that total, 60 documents (124 pages) have been determined to be releasable in some form and 147 documents (515 pages) have been determined to be exempt from release. Each document is identified in the Index by a number assigned to it for this review. The nature of the material withheld as exempt is identified and described to the extent possible without disclosing information that must continue to be protected. The majority of the documents in this case record an official United States Government and foreign government awareness of, and occasional involvement in, developments which received considerable press coverage. As a result, there is little that can be offered in explanation of what information is withheld or why the information is withheld without running a real risk of exposing information which, in combination with information already in the public domain, would probably result in disclosure of information requiring continuing

protection. To disclose any information about the nature of the CIA's tactics and capabilities in collecting intelligence concerning international narcotics trafficking raises the likelihood that such efforts in the future will be negated or defeated. Intelligence sources can be lost and intelligence methods negated once they are known.

To facilitate consideration of the deletions made in the documents released and to demonstrate the context in which the deletions were made, copies of the released versions of the documents accompany this Index.

The list which follows sets forth the categories of information deleted from the documents. The letter designating each category in the listing has been placed on the copies of the documents in a manner intended to show the kind of information removed with each deletion. The categories in the list which follow contain references to the paragraphs in the accompanying affidavit which explain the rationale for the particular category of information withheld. Additionally, the list also shows, with each listed category, the FOIA exemption invoked with deletions of that category of information.

In the case of documents withheld in their entirety, there are normally one or two exemption categories which justify withholding an entire document. There are also, in most such cases, additional exemption categories that provide additional reasons for withholding portions of the document. The exemption categories which may justify withholding an entire document are identified by the use of capitalized letters preceded by an asterisk, e.g., *A. The categories which justify withholding portions of a document are identified by letters which are in lower case, e.g., a.

In the case of documents released with portions deleted, the deleted portions are identified by a letter written in adjacent to the deletion. The lettered category list provides a description of the kind of information withheld.

In instances in which the letter "A" is used to denote information identifying an intelligence source, there is frequently other information which is more nearly circumstantial and which does not provide a direct identification of the source. The letter "B" was not used in such cases for the latter type of information but is implied.

When the letter "C" is used to designate intelligence information received from a foreign intelligence service or security service, such a passage of information would not have taken place without the existence of a liaison arrangement. In such cases the letter "D" is also implied. The letter "D" was not routinely cited in such cases to reduce the volume of repetitive explanations.
