This is in further response to your request on behalf of your client, Harold Weisberg, for access to records in the Offices of the Attorney General and Deputy Attorney General pertaining to the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

Due to an administrative error, certain information was inadvertently deleted from three documents released to you by our letter of April 1, 1981. Enclosed are copies of the three pages as they should have been released (AG #25, page 2; AG #26, page 2; CIV #2). The basis for the excision of the single name appearing in AG #25 and AG #26 will be contained in the "Vaughn" affidavit to be filed with the Court in Civil Action 81-0023.

The right to appeal and to judicial relief regarding this action remain available to Mr. Weisberg as previously stated.

I om providing the following information regarding the assumption of Martin Lather Ming for phatever value it may have in your investigation.

During the years 1963 and 1964 an investigation involving extremist groups was conducted by the Hilam Folice Deprisoment and the Dade County State Attorney. I coordinated that investigation and the records will reflect that incondividuals planned to aspessing to Hertin Eather King.

- 1. In October, 1963, on informer reported a correspondent with ene, Jack Brown, in which Erorn planted to Idli King. Brown then resided in Chartenga, Tennesses, and was Deposited Mixerd of the Dixie Flan.
- 2. In May, 1964, Sidney Bornes, a Michil Lousepainter, made plans to Mill Mory on May 17, 1964, in Mebile, Alderia. Darnes of that time planned to move to Alaberta or Masinelipi.

The above information was provided to the FET during the course of our investigation.
