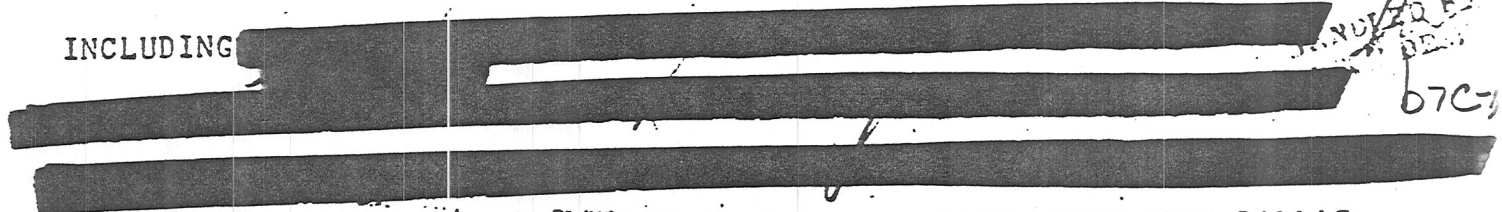
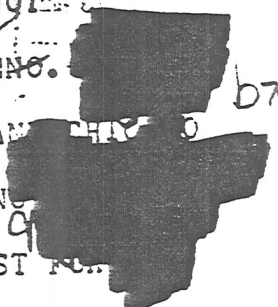

URGENT

JAMES WEINBERG, ETAL, TFIS. REBUTEL THIS DATE. JACK KNAPP NOT IDENTIFIED. NO CRIMINAL RECORD KNOWN THIS OFFICE FOR PAST SEVERAL YEARS. NO ADDITIONAL CONFERENCE HELD BETWEEN SHERIFF ELECT AND GROUP ALTHOUGH KNAPP, JONES AND MR. AND MRS. DONALD BLASKI, IDENTIFIED HERE, WERE IN DALLAS ON NOVEMBER TWENTYFIFTH, LAST MEETING. MEETING AVOIDED BY BUTLER AND GUTHRIE DUE TO SECURITY REASONS. JONES AND KNAPP CONTACTED BUTLER AND GAVE HIM A THREE FIVE SEVEN MAGNUM REVOLVER WHICH JONES CLAIMED TO HAVE PURCHASED IN CHICAGO. JONES, KNAPP AND BLASKI LEFT DALLAS NOVEMBER TWENTYSIX, LAST. JONES RETURNED TO DALLAS ON DECEMBER THIRD, LAST ALONE STATING THAT KNAPP EXPECTED IN DALLAS ON DECEMBER FOURTH, FORTYSIX. GUTHRIE AND DALLAS PD IN ATTEMPT TO GAIN MORE TIME TO EFFECT AND IDENTIFICATION OF KNAPP HAD BUTLER CONTACT JONES AND ADVISE HIM TO KEEP AWAY FROM DALLAS FOR NEXT TEN DAYS AS PD PLANNED A SERIES OF RAIDS ON GAMBLING HOUSES HERE. ALSO PICKUPS WERE TO BE MADE OF OUT OF TOWN HOODLUMS INCLUDING



JONES STATED HE WOULD CONTACT KNAPP AND WOULD KEEP AWAY FROM DALLAS UNTIL HE WAS ADVISED IT WAS OK TO RETURN. RECORDINGS OF MEETINGS HELD ON NOVEMBER FIFTH AND SEVENTH, LAST OBTAINED THIS OFFICE TODAY AND TRANSCRIPTS WILL BE FORWARDED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
