CONGRESSIONAL ACCESS TO FRE FILES

PURPOSE: The purpose of this nenorandum is to advise of recurring problems resulting from Commencional requests for FBI files and to provide an overview of the state.

have requested FRI files for their use. These requests have been for both pending and closed cases as well as for administrative files. Generally, the FTI has declined to furnish files to Consittees of Congress except for the House Assassinations Committee and material already symilable under the Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts (FOI/PA). However, exceptions have been made in a number of instances.

Mr. Adams has advised that release of files to Congress is presenting increasing problems and the FDI may wish to consult with the Department of Justice to determine a formal policy on the release of files.

Furnishing files to Congress involves three problem areas:

1) Legal Issues: The issue of how much material the Congress can require the Executive Branch to produce has not been resolved and
