On 11/6/64 Bureau Agents observed [redacted] a known prostitute accompanied by another white female, in a 1965 Ford Mustang, bearing 1964 Texas License [redacted] at a downtown parking garage. They were accompanied by notorious Dallas criminal lawyer, TOM HOWARD. They subsequently let HOWARD out of the automobile at the Dallas County Courthouse and proceeded directly to the Grand Prairie Police Department Building; at which time the surveillance was discontinued.
