JOHN ROSELLI, aka.
ANTI-RACKETEERING

On 2/15/63, [redacted] advised that during the early morning hours ROSELLI came to his apartment. He was obviously drunk and he was talking to himself. He made a telephone call and asked for [redacted] however, [redacted] was not in. He also made a call to the Beverly Rodeo Hotel, telephone CR 3-0300. He asked for [redacted] penthouse and talked to [redacted] ROSELLI talks to [redacted] like he probably was out with her that evening or out in a party which included her. From the gist of the conversation, ROSELLI indicated that he might have had some trouble with one of his girlfriends earlier in the evening. The balance of the conversation with [redacted] was merely disjointed babblings.

At 9:20 AM, ROSELLI received a telephone call. He indicated to the caller that he was back in town the "other day" and he was in the attorney's office when he was there.

At 10:30 AM, ROSELLI received another telephone call. He told the caller that he was in the low bracket now. ROSELLI indicates that he will write a check to the caller and there is apparently some sort of a drive for donations going on. ROSELLI tells his caller, whose name is [redacted] to call him tomorrow. He asks how [redacted] is.

Shortly before 7:00 PM, ROSELLI entered his apartment. The telephone rang and ROSELLI tells the caller that some friend from Washington just arrived in town and that he had to meet him in the Beverly Hilton Hotel. He says he will take the visitor, who is a man, to Perino's for dinner. The caller asks for an address and telephone number and ROSELLI gives him the number of [redacted] ROSELLI refers to [redacted] the caller as [redacted]
