You will recall that on December 8, 1947, you were advised in a Bureau memorandum captioned "Countess Anna Schaufuss du Rapaport Tolstoy Tolstoy Foundation; Internal Security - R" (New York File 100-37710), that information had been received from the Army indicating that Countess Tolstoy might possibly be a Soviet agent. In your reply dated December 15, 1947, you stated that according to information in your files, there was no indication that various persons connected with the Tolstoy Foundation had any un-American sympathies or were pro-Soviet. In view of this latest allegation concerning the Foundation, it is desired that you give further consideration to this matter during the course of your investigation concerning [REDACTED]
